

## CIMS Level 3 Online (Zoom) Training including NZQA Assessment (US 32158)

Date: Wednesday 27 March, 2024

**Time**: Six hours of learning across three, two hour sessions (participants must attend all three in order to qualify for NZQA assessment

 Sessions run from 08:30am -10:30am, 11:00am -1:00pm, 1:30pm -3:30pm with a short break after each hour of teaching

Cost: only \$150 + GST per student including NZQA Assessment

At the end of the course participants will understand the Coordinated Incident Management System (CIMS) and how it is used across the emergency services, central and local government agencies and private entities.

We ensure that any course participant that wants or needs NZQA accreditation to Unit Standard 32158 will be able to gain the accreditation.

We offer CIMS level 3 courses online (Zoom or Teams), via self-paced videos, or face-to-face and CIMS level 4 courses face-to-face.


